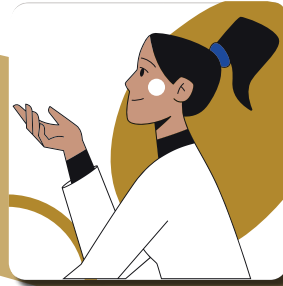
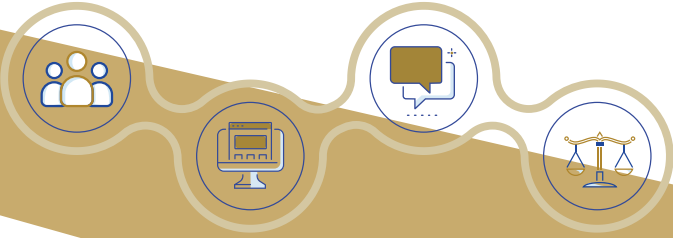

Cultural safety training for health profession accreditation contributors

What do I have to do?

1. Pre-enrolment evaluation – check your knowledge and understanding.
2. Six self-directed modules
 - a. Foundation concepts
 - b. Reflexive practice
 - c. Legacy of colonisation
 - d. Racism
 - e. Solutions
 - f. The application
3. A moderated discussion (6 hours) with other accreditation contributors across the professions to share ideas and discuss learning.

How do I register?

You will need to contact your accreditation authority. They will then send you a link to register online.

How long do I have to do the training?

You will have six months to complete the six online modules. The time is calculated from when you are provided online access to your assessment.

If you need more time please contact your accreditation authority.

Is there a cost?

Your accreditation authority will be covering the cost of the training.

Will the moderated discussions be online or in-person?

Discussions will be online and in-person. You will be able to nominate which session you'd like to attend.

In-person moderated discussions are planned for each of the capital cities.

How do I register for a moderated discussion?

You will be able to choose either an online or in-person session once you have enrolled in the course.

Do I have to complete all of the online modules before I do the moderated discussion?

Yes, you will need to complete all six of the online modules at least 14 days before your moderated discussion session.

You will also need to complete the moderated discussion workshop within 60 days of finishing your online modules.

Can I change which moderated discussion I attend once I've registered?

Yes, but you will need to change your booking at least 14 days prior, otherwise your accreditation authority will be charged an administrative fee.
